It is becoming increasingly recognized that psychotic symptoms are not unique to schizophrenia, but occur frequently in posttraumatic disorders, including PTSD, dissociative disorders and borderline personality disorder. In this workshop, the lead editor of the 2008 book “Psychosis, trauma and dissociation” Professor PHD Andrew Moskowitz from the Department of Psychology, Aarhus University, will discuss possible reasons for this, presenting ways of conceptualizing all of the positive symptoms of schizophrenia from a trauma or dissociation perspective. Clinical, as well as theoretical, implications of this alternate way of viewing psychotic symptoms will be discussed.
